

Applicant will be presented with a quote from City's tree trimming contractor prior to removal. Upon authorization of quote and payment by applicant, tree(s) will be removed by City's tree trimming contractor as their schedule permits. FILING FEE: The applicant shall post a non-refundable filing fee in the amount of \$ 75 along with this request form. **DECISION AND APPEAL:** The decision of the Public Works Director is final, unless appealed by the Applicant, a member of the City Council or an Interested Person. Appeals shall be submitted in writing and filed with the Qity Clerk within 10 days after the decision date identified in the notice of decision. I can't expect my family and friends to walk though this disgusting mess just to get to my front door




