RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, CONFIRMING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF REFUSE, RECYCLING AND ORGANICS COLLECTION FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017.

WHEREAS, Section 5.01.070 of the Culver City Municipal Code authorizes the City Council to establish, by resolution, refuse (including recycling and organics) collection fees (collectively, "Refuse Collection Fees"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard all testimony and considered all objections to the proposed Refuse Collection Fees at a duly noticed public hearing held on July 24, 2017 and has determined to proceed with the levy and collection of Refuse Collection Fees effective July 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.01.070, the City Council hereby overrules any objections and confirms the collection of Refuse Collection Fees at the rates set forth in the Engineer's Report approved on May 30, 2017, for Fiscal Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020, to pay the costs and expenses for the operation, maintenance, repair and improvements necessary to provide the City's refuse, recycling and organics collection services, effective July 1, 2017.
- 2. As set forth in the Engineer's Report, the proposed rate for the Refuse Collection Fees for Culver City residents for Fiscal Years 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 shall increase annually by seven percent (7%) above the rate for the preceding fiscal year.

3. The collection of Refuse Collection Fees as set forth in the
Engineer's Report shall be performed pursuant to law, including CCMC Section
5.01.070.B, which provides for collection of fees by placement on the property tax bills
or by monthly billing. For residential service, the County Auditor shall enter on the
County Assessment Roll the amount of the assessment and the assessment shall be
collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County property taxes are
collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the assessment shall be
paid to the City of Culver City. Commercial service shall be billed monthly.

- 4. Upon receipt of monies representing assessments collected by the County, the City shall deposit the monies into a special fund known as the "Sanitation Enterprise Fund."
- 5. Immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Resolution, which includes the Engineer's Report containing the approved refuse collection fees, with the County Auditor.
- 6. A certified copy of the Engineer's Report shall also be filed in the Office of the City Engineer, with a duplicate copy on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and shall be open for public inspection.
