The purpose of this report is to provide the Council and residents a status update on Measure Y revenue activity that occurred in the City. This report captures Measure Y sales tax collections through the third quarter of the 2016-17 Fiscal Year.



FISCAL YEAR 2017: QUARTER 3 MEASURE Y REVENUE

Through the third quarter of Fiscal Year 2017, Measure Y sales tax collections total \$7.1 million, or 76.6 percent of budgeted revenue. Third quarter Measure Y revenue tracked \$0.3 million (3.9 percent) higher than prior year receipts. This quarter also benefitted from improved Building and Construction receipts, which grew 17.8 percent over the second auarter. General Consumer Goods account for the City's largest sources of Measure Y sales tax revenues, with continued growth of 1.5 percent over the same period last year.

Cumulatively, a total of \$34.9 million in revenue has been raised since the measure's implementation.

Measure Y funds are budgeted as part of the annual budget approval process by the City Council. Funds received are deposited into the City's General Fund and allocated to sustain general municipal functions.

easure Y is a voter-approved one-half percent Use transaction and tax adopted to maintain City of Culver City critical services. With limited exceptions, the transactions and use tax is imposed on the goods and same merchandise as the local sales and use tax. The 10-year measure aained overwhelming voter approval in November 2012 and went into effect April 2013 to provide necessary resources to resolve the City's structural deficit issues and continue services existing at levels. Measure Y contains a sunset provision, which will result the expiration of the measure on March 31, 2023 if not reauthorized by voters.
