VISION ZERO...

- Is a policy commitment to reduce fatal and severe collisions to zero by a certain date
- Acknowledges that traffic collision deaths and serious injuries are preventable through safer street design
- Takes a multidisciplinary approach (public works, police, health, schools, emergency response)
- Involves physical changes, education, and enforcement

Vision Zero Cities A Vision Zero City meets the following minimum standards: Vision Zero City - Sets clear goal of eliminating traffic fatalities and severe injuries - Mayor has publicly, officially committed to Vision Zero - Vision Zero plan or strategy is in place, or Mayor has committed to doing Considering so in clear time frame Vision Zero - Key city departments (including Police, Transportation and Public Health) are engaged. 











VICTIMS BY MODE






