

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY,  
CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING RESPONSIBLE LEGISLATION TO LEGALIZE DOMESTIC  
FERRETS AS HOUSE PETS IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**WHEREAS**, domestic ferrets are legal house pets in 48 states; and

**WHEREAS**, domestic ferrets are a popular house pet without any documented detrimental environmental effects; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Fish and Game Commission justifies the ban on domestic ferrets with reasons that have been disproven or discredited; and

**WHEREAS**, the continued prohibition on the ownership of domestic ferrets precludes residence of Culver City and other cities from owning their companion animal of choice; and

**WHEREAS**, the State prohibition on owning ferrets is an example of regulation without purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, **DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

1. Recognizes the 1932 state ban on owning domestic ferrets as household pets as illogical and unjustified.
2. Requests California Legislatures to remedy this issue with a responsible ferret legalization legislation.
3. Supports the efforts of those seeking ferret legalization in California.
