A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING RESPONSIBLE LEGISLATION TO LEGALIZE DOMESTIC FERRETS AS HOUSE PETS IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, domestic ferrets are legal house pets in 48 states; and

WHEREAS, domestic ferrets are a popular house pet without any documented detrimental environmental effects; and

WHEREAS, the California Fish and Game Commission justifies the ban on domestic ferrets with reasons that have been disproven or discredited; and

WHEREAS, the continued prohibition on the ownership of domestic ferrets precludes residence of Culver City and other cities from owning their companion animal of choice; and

WHEREAS, the State prohibition on owning ferrets is an example of regulation without purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, **DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

- 1. Recognizes the 1932 state ban on owning domestic ferrets as household pets as illogical and unjustified.
- 2. Requests California Legislatures to remedy this issue with a responsible ferret legalization legislation.
- 3. Supports the efforts of those seeking ferret legalization in California.
