Item A-2

Request from Culver City Employees' Association (CCEA) to Appeal a Disciplinary Action and Schedule and Open Hearing

Serena Wright-Black, Administrative Services Director, provided a summary of the material of record.

Chair Daly Redholtz invited public input.

The following members of the audience addressed the Commission:

Nik Soukonnikov, CCEA, noted that the matter on appeal was not a one-day suspension, but rather a pay step reduction for a one pay period and he added that the fact that it was not a suspension is the substance of the appeal.

Discussion ensued between Mr. Soukonnikov and Commissioners regarding the estimated length of time for the appeal to be heard; clarification regarding the two-step temporary pay demotion for a pay period; and clarification that the rule mandated a suspension rather than a step demotion.

Sarah Martoccia, Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Rudd & Romo, spoke, appearing for Jay Trinnaman, to discuss available dates; she discussed the anticipated amount of time estimated for the City presentation; and the Rule 11 pre-hearing conference.

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding dates for the hearing and the feeling that a pre-hearing conference is not necessary.
