3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, EXPRESSING SUPPORT
5 FOR EVERYONE IN, A COALITION OF PEOPLE WHO
6 EMBRACE THE COMMON GOAL OF ENDING
7 HOMELESSNESS.

8 WHEREAS, the City of Culver City and the County of Los Angeles are
9 facing a growing homelessness problem, endangering the health and safety of our
10 homeless neighbors; and

11 WHEREAS, 1.5 million voters across the County, and voters in Culver City
12 committed to ending homelessness by passing Measure H; and

13 WHEREAS, voters passed a comprehensive set of coordinated, well-
14 funded solutions providing the services, rental subsidies, outreach, housing, and
15 prevention we need to bring our homeless neighbors off the streets, for good; and

16 WHEREAS, on November 28, 2016 the City Council adopted Resolution
17 2016-R113 to partner with Los Angeles County to combat homelessness; and

18 WHEREAS, on July 9, 2018, through a Measure H funding grant, in an
19 effort to better address the needs of the homeless and households at risk for
20 homelessness, the City Council and Culver City Housing Authority approved the updated
21 Culver City's Plan to Prevent and Combat Homelessness; and

22 WHEREAS, accountability and transparency will be needed to give the
23 public a clear picture of where progress is being made and where we need more action to
24 meet the following ambitious countywide goals by July 1, 2022:

- 25 • End homelessness for 45,000 families and individuals;
- 26 • Prevent homelessness for 30,000 families and individuals; and
- 27 • Approve 5,000 units of supportive housing for our most vulnerable
28 neighbors; and

1 WHEREAS, the Everyone In movement, powered by the United Way of
2 Greater Los Angeles, will help keep the promise to end homelessness by creating ways for
3 the public to get involved; tracking, measuring, and sharing progress; and lifting up
4 successes and celebrating wins.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
6 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

8 The City Council of the City of Culver City supports, endorses and hereby
9 directs the City Manager to communicate this support of the Everyone In campaign to the
10 Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, Culver City residents, Westside Cities Council
11 of Governments and the media.
