RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY'S MEASURE W – SAFE CLEAN WATER PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Culver City recognizes the need to meet State regulations and the Federal Clean Water Act in order to improve water quality within our boundaries:

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) has promulgated 21 Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) regulating the discharges of trash, bacteria, nutrients, metals, toxic sediment, and other pollutants into the City's receiving waters and watersheds;

WHEREAS, the TMDLs have interim and final compliance milestones that require compliance over the next 25 years;

WHEREAS, non-compliance with TMDL interim and final milestones could expose the City to third party lawsuits as well as fines and penalties from the State;

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors has placed Measure W, the Safe Clean Water Program (Program) before the voters on November 6, 2018 ballot;

WHEREAS, the goal of the proposed Measure W is to use the parcel tax to support multi-benefit stormwater projects and programs that improve water quality, increase water supply, and provide community benefits;

WHEREAS, Measure W will generate annual revenue of approximately \$300 million Countywide by implementing a special parcel tax of 2.5 cents per square foot of

1	impermeable surface area on private property in the Los Angeles County Flood Control
2	District;
3	WHEREAS, the revenue from Measure W will assist the City in meeting
4	water quality compliance regulations through various projects and programs with an
5	emphasis on implementing multi-benefit stormwater infrastructure;
6	WHEREAS, these projects will also provide local water supply, flood
7 8	protection, address localized flooding, supporting access to local jobs and helping meet
9	environmental justice objectives for the City; and
10	WHEREAS, Measure W includes strict accountability requirements, including
11	an independent oversight committee and independent annual audits.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
13	HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
14	The City of Culver City supports Los Angeles County's Measure W – Safe
15 16	Clean Water Program, and the related elements and parcel tax, on the ballot for
17	consideration by voters on November 6, 2018.
