

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 3.01.100 OF
THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE
ESTABLISHING CITY COUNCIL AUTHORITY TO
SET REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING DATES
BY RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, as a result of the April 10, 2016 General Municipal Election, The Culver City Charter (Charter) Section 608 was amended to authorize the City Council to determine the regular meeting dates of the City Council by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, Culver City Municipal Code (CCMC) Section 3.01.100, currently provides that all official, regular and adjourned meetings of the City Council shall be held in the City Hall on the second and fourth Mondays of each month at 7:00 p.m.; and further provides that a regular meeting that will fall on a legal holiday shall instead be held on the next succeeding day; and

WHEREAS, for consistency with Charter Section 608, the City Council desires to amend CCMC Section 3.01.100 to authorize the City Council to set regular meeting dates by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3.01.100 is hereby amended as follows (additions indicated by underlined text):

§3.01.100 Time and Place.

All official, regular and adjourned meetings of the City Council shall be held in the City Hall on the second and fourth Mondays of each month at 7:00 p.m., unless otherwise specified by resolution of the City Council. In the event there is a need to hold a closed session, the City Council meeting for closed session purposes will convene at a time either prior to or after the regular Council session on the same date, with the regular Council session to commence at 7:00 p.m. If any regular meeting shall fall on a legal holiday, no meeting shall be

1 held on such holiday, but shall be held on the next succeeding day thereafter that is not a
2 holiday at 7:00 p.m. **LEGAL HOLIDAY**, as used in this section, shall mean New Year's Day,
3 Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day,
4 Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day and the following day, and Christmas.

5 **SECTION 2:** The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section,
6 subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this Ordinance is rendered or declared
7 invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason or
8 any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently adopted the
9 remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, or words of this
10 Ordinance, and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.

11 **SECTION 3:** Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance shall
12 take effect thirty days after its adoption. Pursuant to Section 616 and 621 of the City Charter,
13 prior to the expiration of fifteen days after the adoption, the City Clerk shall cause this
14 Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the Culver City News and shall post this
15 Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three places within the City.
