RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PORTIONS OF WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, CULVER BOULEVARD AND CENTINELA AVENUE IN CONNECTION WITH THE CICLAVIA CULVER CITY EVENT, A CITY SPONSORED EVENT, TO BE HELD ON MARCH 3, 2019 AND ADOPTING RELATED RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 21101(e) of the California Vehicle Code provides local authorities, for those highways under their jurisdiction, may adopt rules and regulations by ordinance or resolution on certain matters, including temporarily closing a portion of any street for celebrations, parades, local special events, and other purposes when, in the opinion of local authorities having jurisdiction or a public officer or employee that the local authority designates by resolution, the closing is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and,

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2018, the City submitted a joint application with the City of Los Angeles and CicLAvia for grant funds through Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority's (Metro) Open Streets Program for the CicLAvia Culver City event (CicLAvia 2019); and,

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2018, the City received notification from Metro that the joint application was approved; and,

WHEREAS, the temporary closing of portions of Washington Boulevard, Culver Boulevard and Centinela Avenue (collectively "Subject Streets") is necessary for

the safety and protection of the persons who are to use those portions of the Subject Streets during the temporary closing for CicLAvia 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- The City Council hereby approves the temporary closing of the Subject Streets in connection with CicLAvia 2019.
- 2. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the closing of the Subject Streets is necessary for the safety and protection of persons who are to use those portions of the Subject Streets during the temporary closing for CicLAvia 2019.
- The rules and regulations applicable to the closure of the Subject Streets for CicLAvia 2019 shall be those set forth in the Permit approved by the City's Committee on Permits and Licenses.
- 4. Further, the City Manager, Police Chief, and Director of Public Works/City Engineer or their duly authorized designees are hereby designated to impose additional rules and regulations as they may deem appropriate for the safety and protection of persons who are to use those portions of the Subject Streets during the temporary closing for CicLAvia 2019.
