The purpose of this report is to provide the Council and residents a status update on Measure CW revenue and expenditure activity that occurred in the City. This report captures all Measure CW activity through the 2017-18 Fiscal Year.

Measure CW is the City of Culver City's Clean Water, Clean Beach Parcel Tax approved by voters in November 2016. The Measure establishes a dedicated funding source to reduce and help prevent water pollution in Ballona Creek, Marina del Rey Harbor, Santa Monica Bay, and the Pacific Ocean.
