	2) To increase pedestrian mobility, safety, and reduce vehicle speeds, at the intersections along Higuera, as indicated in the enclosed DESCRIPTION OF TEMPORARY PROPOSALS document, the installation of a) redesigned traffic circles/islands; b) painted high-visibility (piano keys) crosswalks; c) "Yield Here to Pedestrians" signs; d) pavement-painted "STOP" and stop bar, adjusted farther back to accommodate the painted crosswalks; and e) and curb extensions to slow down traffic?			
	3) To increase pedestrian mobility, safety, and reduce vehicle speeds, on Ince, after conclusion of construction at The Culver Studios, when the street is no longer needed for construction staging, the installation of a) painted high-visibility (piano keys) crosswalks; b) "Yield Here to Pedestrians" signs; and c) speed humps/speed cushions to slow down excessive speeding?
