What defines a district? What's in a district name?

Successful, identifiable, nameable districts have one or more of these characteristics:

- —unique architectural character Old Pasadena, Chinatown, Gas Lamp
- —density of single business type or activity Toy District, Fashion District, DTLA Arts District
- —dominant geographical/physical characteristic Bunker Hill, Nob Hill, River Walk
- —dominant well-known building or structure Flatiron, Helms Bakery, Railroad Sa-Santa Rosa

- well-known, colorful history Cannery Row, Meatpacking District, Old Sacramento
- density of entertainment/dining/shopping Georgetown, Belmont Shore, Larchmont, Westwood
- associated street name Third Street, Rush Street-Chicago, 16th Street-Denver
- grassroots nickname Soho, WeHo, NoHo
