CITY OF CULVER CITY ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY STATEMENT

Policy Number: <u>I-05</u> Effective Date: Rev. 8/99

Subject: Flags on City Flag Poles Source/Authority: CAO; City Council-Background

PURPOSE:

The <u>primary</u> purpose of City flag poles is displaying the American, California and Culver City flags. On occasion, the City Council or Chief Administrative OfficerCity Manager may permit the appearance of some other flag. As that can be interpreted as a political or patriotic statement, the decision to allow display of other flags must be weighed carefully and approval must be based upon fair and consistent standards.

STATEMENT OF POLICY:

Flag protocol, respecting the U.S. Flag and the display standards established by the U.S. Congress, shall be observed.

As a matter of custom and practice, the <u>CAOCity Manager</u> shall order the lowering of flags <u>to half-staff</u> over City buildings and facilities in respect for:

- a. City employees, <u>Council Members and Commissioners</u> who die while in City service (up to five days)
- b. Observance of Veterans' and Memorial Day holidays (on the day)
- c. Observance of National days of mourning (as specified by Presidential or Congressional declaration)

The <u>CAOCity Manager</u> or City Council, in their discretion, may authorize a lowering of the U.S. Flag to half-staff at one or more City facilities for other <u>observancesspecial event recognition</u>, such as the observance of an anniversary of a specific battle in which U.S. forces were engaged. The duration of such observances shall be at the discretion of the <u>CAOCity Manager</u> and City Council.

Should the U.S. Flag already be at half-staff at the time of a state or national declaration of mourning, the U.S. Flag should be hoisted to the top of the flag pole and then lowered to half-staff in observance of such declaration of mourning.

Display of other flags for the purpose of participation in a period of <u>local</u>, state or national observance shall be determined by the <u>Chief Administrative OfficerCity</u> <u>Manager</u>, and the display <u>shall will</u> be limited to that specific period.
