RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, (1) AUTHORIZING CITY'S **PARTICIPATION CALRECYCLE** IN THE **BEVERAGE** CONTAINER RECYCLING PILOT PROJECT: (2) APPROVING RECYCLING SOCAL AS CITY'S **PILOT** PROJECT OPERATOR AND APPROVING OPERATOR'S PROPOSED METHOD OF OPERATION AND REDEMPTION SITES: AND (3) AUTHORIZING SOCAL RECYCLING'S SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in 2017, Senate Bill 458 authorized Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle") to approve up to five pilot projects proposed by jurisdictions to provide convenient beverage container redemption in both urban and rural areas that do not have enough recycling opportunities ("Pilot Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Pilot Project requires that local jurisdictions and recycling center operators work closely together to provide more redemption opportunities for consumers; and

WHEREAS, Culver City meets the eligibility requirements to apply for and participate in the Pilot Project; and

WHEREAS, SoCal Recycling is proposing to provide mobile recycling units at two locations and provide services on various days of the week at both locations and on Saturdays.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for the Pilot Project on behalf of the City of Culver City.
- 2. The City of Culver City approves SoCal Recycling ("SoCal") as its Pilot Project operator, and approves SoCal's proposed method of operation (mobile recycling sites).

1	3. The City of Culver City approves SoCal's proposed redemption sites in
2	Culver City at (1) Raintree Plaza, located at the corner of Jefferson and Overland; and (2)
3	Pavillions, located at 11030 Jefferson Boulevard.
4	4. The City of Culver City authorizes SoCal's submittal of an application to
5	CalRecycle to participate as City's Pilot Project operator.
6	5. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or his/her designee, to
7	execute all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements and
8	amendments, necessary to implement the Pilot Project.
