

The Regular City Council Meeting for March 16, 2020 has been Cancelled



Please note the same agenda items will be placed on an upcoming Special City Council Meeting.

The Special Meeting is expected to occur on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 via teleconference.\*

A separate notification will be sent when the agenda is made available.

The cancellation is due to <u>new recommendations from public health officials</u> to postpone or cancel certain gatherings due to safety concerns surrounding coronavirus (COVID-19).

The Special Meeting will take place via teleconference in order to allow for social distancing to help slow the spread of coronavirus and protect at-risk populations (such as older adults, those with underlying health conditions, and pregnant women) as recommended by public health officials. The Council will participate from remote teleconference locations and will not be in the Council Chambers. In the interest of public health, the public is encouraged to participate remotely and submit any comments via email.

<u>How to Participate Remotely:</u> Meetings can be viewed live in Culver City on Channel 35 by Time Warner subscribers, on Channel 37 by Verizon FIOS subscribers and, for AT&T Uverse subscribers, by going to Channel 99.
