Notes

1. **Sanitation** - All Safe Parking programs bathroom and hand-washing facilities, typically in the form of portapotties, arranged and paid for by Safe Parking LA unless the local facility allows access to restrooms on site.
2. **Case Management** - All safe parking programs are meant to be an intervention in someone’s experience being homeless, intending to prevent them from losing their vehicle and falling further into homelessness. While direct case management is available through the Coordinated Entry System based on need, Safe Parking LA provides some “light touch” services that help people find community solutions that can help them find their own pathway back into housing.
3. **Auto Services Provided** - Limited auto repairs as well as registration and insurance are provided. It is an allowable expense if publicly funded but not always budgeted. Safe Parking LA programs offer it through approved vendors and for certain but not all repairs.
4. **2018 Homeless Count Stats** - 26 Persons in Cars, 9 Persons in Vans, 27 Persons in RVs / Campers.
5. **2019 Homeless Count Stats** - 61 Persons in Cars, 6 Persons in Vans, and 23 Persons in RVs / Campers.
