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RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, (1) APPROVING AN AMENDED ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORT; AND (2) CONFIRMING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF REFUSE, RECYCLING AND ORGANICS COLLECTION FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020.

WHEREAS, Section 5.01.070 of the Culver City Municipal Code authorizes the City Council to establish, by resolution, refuse (including recycling and organics) collection fees (collectively, "Refuse Collection Fees"); and

WHEREAS, these proceedings relate to the levy and collection of Refuse Collection Fees effective July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, projected revenue requirements and rate adjustments were adopted by the City Council on July 24, 2017 for fiscal years 2017/2018 through 2019/2020; and

WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2019/2020, a comprehensive rate analysis for the Refuse Collection Fees was completed for fiscal years 2020/2021 through 2024/2025, which was scheduled to be presented to the City Council in May 2020; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and its effect on the economy, the consideration of the rate analysis has been postponed and the Refuse Collection Fees previously adopted and levied for fiscal year 2019/2020 will be continued through fiscal year 2020/2021, as reflected in the Second Amendment to the City Engineer's Report for Refuse and Recycling User's Services Charges Beginning Fiscal Year 2020-2021 ("Amended Engineer's Report"); and

WHEREAS, the Amended Engineer's Report has been filed with the City Clerk and submitted to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully examined and reviewed the Amended Engineer's Report as presented and is satisfied with the proposed report and each and all of the budget items and documents as set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard all testimony and considered all objections to the proposed Refuse Collection Fees at a duly noticed public meeting on August 3, 2020 and has determined to proceed with the levy and collection of Refuse Collection Fees effective July 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The Amended Engineer's Report as presented, consisting of the following: the estimated costs of operation, maintenance, repair and improvements for the provision of refuse, recycling and organics collection services, and the formulas used to determine that the proposed fees accurately reflect a portion of the current costs to provide such services, is hereby approved and is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and open for public inspection. Reference is made to the Amended Engineer's Report for a full detailed description of the proposed Refuse Collection Fees.
- 2. As recommended in the Amended Engineer's Report, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and its effect on the economy, the Refuse Collection Fees adopted and levied for fiscal year 2019/2020 shall continue through fiscal year 2020/2021.
- 3. Pursuant to CCMC Section 5.01.070, the City Council hereby overrules any objections and confirms the collection of Refuse Collection Fees at the rates

- 4. The collection of Refuse Collection Fees as set forth in the Engineer's Report shall be performed pursuant to law, including CCMC Section 5.01.070.B, which provides for collection of fees by placement on the property tax bills or by monthly billing. For residential service, the County Auditor shall enter on the County Assessment Roll the amount of the assessment and the assessment shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County property taxes are collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the assessment shall be paid to the City of Culver City. Commercial service shall be billed monthly.
- 5. Upon receipt of monies representing assessments collected by the County, the City shall deposit the monies into a special fund known as the "Sanitation Enterprise Fund."
- 6. Immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Resolution, which includes the Amended Engineer's Report containing the approved Refuse Collection Fees, with the County Auditor.
