THE CITY:

Culver City is a Charter City incorporated in 1917, and is a destination filled with outdoor cafes, unique shops and galleries opening onto pedestrian-friendly boulevards. Culver City has a dedicated staff of approximately 700+ employees with an overall operating budget of over \$200 million. The City provides a full range of municipal services including Fire, Police, Community Development, Public Works, Parks, Recreation, and Community Services, and Transportation.

## THE POSITION:

This classified management position reports to the Maintenance Operations Manager and is responsible for supervising, prioritizing, assigning and reviewing the work of skilled and semi-skilled workers engaged in the maintenance, repair, and construction of the municipally owned street lighting system, traffic signals, air conditioning/heating, and electrical systems within City facilities City property, buildings, systems and structures ("City facilities"). Responsibilities also include assuring that the City facilities and their equipment are preventatively maintained and kept in an operable condition. Assures that the facilities reflect a clean, safe and pleasant environment, supervising and coordinating the City's facilities maintenance services; monitoring schedules and budgets, and ensuring that City facilities and equipment are clean, safe and preventatively maintained and that building maintenance resources are effectively and efficiently utilized.

This position is located in the Transportation Department. The incumbent of this position routinely plans, <u>assigns</u>, coordinates, supervises, and evaluates the work of <u>a number of crews</u> of workers, e.g. supervision of skilled and semi-skilled Maintenance Electricians, Traffic Signal Technicians, Air Conditioning and Heating Technicians, Custodians, Maintenance Plumber, Maintenance Carpenters, Maintenance Painters and Facilities Maintenance Wworkers. Identifies and determines resources required for the installation, maintenance and repair of

the Transportation building, structures such as bus stops, and LED and other electrical services related to Transportation equipment.

Theis person in this position assists in the development and management of major and minor improvement projects for the City buildings and facilities. Participates directly in complex and difficult on-site maintenance, service, repair, and construction activities. Responds to citizen and City building tenant inquiries and complaints in a courteous and meaningful manner. Prepares monthly and quarterly reports. Maintains various computerized work records related to the development of reports. Conducts periodic surveys of the City's street lighting system, traffic signal system, and City facilities to determine maintenance and repair needs. Inspects all new construction on City-owned property related to electrical maintenance. Reviews plans for traffic signals and street lighting, and City facilities for future City projects. Utilizes computerized building management program to monitor service, parts, inventory, records, work goals, budget and the preventative maintenance program; maintains records and logs of work performed, and equipment and staffing usage; prepares reports; prepares and administers the budget for area of responsibility. Reviews and prepares plans and specifications for contract work. Inspects and evaluates work in progress and upon completion to ensure compliance to standards and contractual terms. Performs related duties as assigned.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

## **Education and Experience**

High school diploma or equivalent in addition to five years of journey level experience in <u>facilities, mechanical or</u> electrical maintenance, repair, servicing, installation, and construction including two years of experience as a <u>supervisor or</u> lead worker.

# **License & Certificate**

Possession of a valid California Class <u>BC</u> driver license. <u>Must maintain Supervisor Asbestos</u> <u>Certification.</u>

## **EXAMINATION PROCEDURES:**

Applications will be reviewed and the most appropriately qualified applicants will be invited to participate in a written examination weighted at 50%. Those qualifying on the written test will be invited to an appraisal interview weighted at 50%. Applicants must pass each stage of the recruitment process in order to be placed on the eligible list.

Applicants must receive a passing score on all of the following examination components in order to be placed on the eligible list. **Please note:** There is a six (6) month waiting period to re-test; therefore, applicants who have participated in the examination process within the

preceding six (6) months will be deferred and will need to re-apply after the six (6) month waiting period.

Written Exercise/Exam (weighted at 30%): To assess the ability to manage the installation, maintenance and repair of facilities (Tentatively scheduled for ).

<u>Counseling Exercise (weighted at 30%):</u> To demonstrate the ability to supervise (Tentatively scheduled for ).

<u>Oral Appraisal Interview (weighted at 40%):</u> To evaluate training, experience and personal qualifications (*Tentatively scheduled for* ).

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:
