A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING \$9,571.00 IN STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF DUODOTES, AND PROVIDING PROOF OF AUTHORITY AS REQUIRED BY THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS), through its Office of Grants and Training, provides financial assistance to the California State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), through the California Governor's office of Emergency Services (Cal OES), to address unique equipment, training, organization, exercise and planning needs, to assist emergency personnel throughout the state to build effective prevention and protection capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018 the USDHS made a federal award to SHSP with a performance period of September 1, 2018 to May 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Cal OES provides funds to various California counties, including the County of Los Angeles, as its Subgrantees, with said funds being distributed by the counties to other specified jurisdictions within each county; and

WHEREAS, in the 2021 regional application for SHSP funds, the Culver City Fire Department (CCFD) included a request to replace its existing cache of duodotes, also known as nerve agent antidote kits, which are to be used during a Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and high yield Explosives (CBRNE) response (the "Project") but the request was not approved and instead placed on a contingency list; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles notified CCFD in March 2021 that the County could distribute unused 2018 SHSP grant funds to the City of Culver City, as

27 28 a Subrecipient, in the amount of \$9,571.00 to purchase the duodotes, and the City of Culver City desires to accept the 2018 SHSP grant funds from the County of Los Angeles; and

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WHEREAS, the performance period for the project ends on May 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of obtaining the 2018 SHSP grant funds, the City Council must provide written Proof of Authority in support of the Project for which the SHSP grant funds will be used, and agree to the provisions of the 2018 Grant Assurances.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
 12 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes and supports the CCFD Project for which CCFD will use the 2018 SHSP grant funds.

2. By the adoption of this Resolution, the City Council provides this Proof of Authority as required by the Cal OES Standard Assurances and agrees as follows:

(a) To provide all matching funds required for the grant
 project and that any cash match will be appropriated as
 required;

(b) Any liability arising out of the performance of this
agreement shall be the responsibility of the Applicant City,
and the City Council, as the authorized governing body of
the City;

4	(d) The City Manager, who is the official executing the
5	agreement is, in fact, authorized to do so.
