RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING INTERIM 2045 JOBS AND HOUSING GROWTH FORECASTS.

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2021-006, which amended Culver City Municipal Code (CCMC) Subchapter 15.06.500, et seq. to establish Mobility Improvement Fees for new development projects to pay their fair share towards the funding of the City's interim mobility improvements and programs project list ("Project List"), intended to reduce vehicle miles traveled and needed to support projected jobs and housing growth; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development, Public Works, and Transportation Departments identified the Project List, which a Mobility Improvement Fee will partially fund, needed to support new development based on the 2045 interim growth forecasts, which resulted in about 22,000 new jobs and 9,000 new residential dwelling units.

WHEREAS, the City is currently updating its General Plan and Circulation/Mobility

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to adopt the interim 2045 growth forecasts of 9,000 new residential housing units and 22,000 jobs until such time that they can be updated following adoption of the updated General Plan. Following adoption of the updated General Plan, the City should update the 2045 growth forecasts should they differ from the forecasts adopted herein; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed a nexus study for the Mobility Improvement Fee, prepared by Fehr & Peers ("Nexus Study") dated May 2021 to analyze the relationship

between vehicle miles traveled associated with new development projects, the need to implement the Project List to support development associated with 2045 interim growth forecasts, and quantifies the fees related to new development projects based on residential and non-residential land uses to pay fair share fees towards the Project List in compliance with the Mitigation Fee Act (California Government Code Section 66000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, adoption of this interim growth forecast is exempt from further environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations ("CEQA Guidelines") Section 15061(b)(3) because the forecast will not allow for or encourage any more development than is already anticipated under the City's existing General Plan and as regulated by existing zoning, or otherwise allow for or promote physical changes in the environment, and therefore, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the forecast will have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2021, at a duly noticed public hearing, the City Council considered adoption of the 2045 interim growth forecasts; and

WHEREAS, after giving the public an opportunity to be heard and considering all information before it, the City Council approved the adoption of said 2045 interim growth forecasts, consisting of about 22,000 new jobs and 9,000 new residential dwelling units.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The 2045 interim growth forecasts used to inform the Mobility Improvement Fees Ordinance and associated Project List shall be about 22,000 new jobs and 9,000 new residential dwelling units, are hereby approved and may only be amended by resolution of the City Council.
