Summary of Proposed Increased Maximum Number of Delivery-only Retail, Manufacturing, Distribution, Cultivation (Indoors), and Testing Laboratory Cannabis Business Permits by Business Type in Culver City

It is proposed that the City of Culver City will issue up to the maximum number of permits by permit type as follows:

| Distribution          | 7 <sup>B</sup>  | 0  | + 3 to accommodate current permittees and applicants<br><br>+5 for potential new businesses   | 15                          |
| Cultivation (Indoors) | 1   | 1  | + 1 - There were no applicants for this permit during the initial application period. However, since that time there have been some inquiries by potential applicants, including one current permittee. | 2                           |
| Testing Laboratory    | 4   | 4  | 0 – There were no applicants for the testing lab permits during the initial application period.   | 4                           |

<sup>A</sup> In accordance with the Culver City Municipal Code Section 11.17.025, storefront retail permit holders may also do home delivery, without an additional delivery-only retail permit.

<sup>B</sup> Currently, distribution and/or delivery permits issued to a manufacturing permit holder (pertaining to its manufacturing business and on the same property) do not count towards the maximum number of distribution or delivery-only permits allowed. Staff recommends that this treatment be changed as described below.

**Treatment of Distribution and Delivery Only Permits issued to a Manufacturing Permit Holder**

Previously distribution and/or delivery permits issued to a manufacturing permit holder (pertaining to its manufacturing business and on the same property) will not count towards the maximum number of distribution or delivery-only permits allowed. Now, any distribution and/or delivery permits issued to a manufacturing permit holder (pertaining to its manufacturing business and on the same property or not pertaining to its manufacturing business and/or not on the same property) will be treated the same as any other permit.
