THE CITY:

Culver City is a Charter City incorporated in 1917, and is a destination filled with outdoor cafes, unique shops and galleries opening onto pedestrian-friendly boulevards. Culver City has a dedicated staff of approximately 700+ employees with an overall operating budget of over \$238 million. The City provides a full range of municipal services including Fire, Police, Community Development, Public Works, Parks, Recreation, and Community Services, and Transportation.

THE POSITION:

The positions assigned to this classification are responsible for checking residential, industrial, and commercial building plans for structural integrity and conformity with construction codes. Incumbents in this classification may not perform all of these tasks, or may perform similar related tasks not listed here.

- Checks the more complicated and involved building plans for structural integrity and compliance with construction codes, zoning regulations, local ordinances, and state laws.
- Provides information to the public about ordinances regulating construction and property development.
- Approves and issues permits.
- Interprets code requirements for and consults with architects, contractors, property owners, building
 inspectors, and the public on all aspects of building design and construction.
- May inspect building and construction work to verify compliance with safety standards and codes. Assists
 in training of construction inspectors.
- Assures plans comply with local planning, zoning, engineering and redevelopment. In coordination with other City offices serves as key position responsible for tracking the plan check time/building permit issuance process.
- Oversees contract consultant work when applicable.

<u>Training and Experience</u>: Any combination equivalent to training and experience that could likely provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities would be qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge, skills, and abilities would be: A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university <u>with major coursework in civil engineering</u>, architecture or related field. -Aand three years of progressively responsible experience performing <u>building plan checking</u>, structural design, or related professional engineering work. Municipal building/structure <u>plan check experiences highly desirable</u>. in civil, construction, or structural engineering and zoning.

<u>License and Certificates</u>: Possession of a valid California Class C driver's license. Possession of an <u>Engineer in training Certificate or a Plan Check Certification</u>, by the International Conference of Building Officials. <u>State of California license as a Civil Engineer or Structural Engineer or Architect</u>. Certification as a Building Plans <u>Examiner by the International Code Council (ICC) or an equivalent nationally recognized organization</u>, required prior to completion of the probationary period.

EXAMINATION PROCEDURES:

Applicants must receive a passing score on all the following examination components in order to be placed on the eligible list. **Please note**: There is a six month waiting period to re-test; therefore, applicants

who have participated in the examination process within the preceding six (6) months will be deferred and will need to re-apply after the six (6) month waiting period.
