The LRSP recommendations serve to ensure that safety improvements are made in a manner that is fair and equitable for all Culver City residents; and WHEREAS, the proposed LRSP contains corrective measures covering

traffic safety education, means for encouraging the use of sustainable modes of travel,
engineering/infrastructure improvements, enforcement, emerging technologies, and

20 meetings of the Mobility, Traffic and Parking Subcommittee and the Bicycle and
21 Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC), respectively; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2021, the City Council held a duly noticed
public meeting, fully considering the proposed LRSP and related staff report, including all
pertinent facts, information, proposals, recommendations, environmental information;
hearing all public testimony presented; and providing a full opportunity for public input and
participation respecting all parts of the LRSP; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City Council determined the LRSP is exempt from CEQA, as set forth in this 2 Resolution. 3

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City resolves as 4 follows: 5

6 1. Pursuant to the foregoing recitations, the City Council finds the Local 7 Road Safety Plan (LRSP) to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following: 8

- A. CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), as it can be seen with certainty there is no possibility the proposed LRSP will have a significant effect on the environment. The LRSP, by itself, does not result in any physical changes in the environment because it is a guiding document and plan that establishes policies, programs and design guidelines intended to make the road network in Culver City safe, comfortable, and convenient for all road users, and is not in conjunction with any specific approval of a physical project. Therefore, any project implemented under the proposed LRSP, would be subject to appropriate CEQA analysis at the time of project implementation; and
 - B. CEQA Guidelines 15301 (c), as the proposed LRSP consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. Such facilities include existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety, and other alterations such as the
