Discussion of November Agenda

Discussion ensued between staff and Committee Members regarding participation by the Parks Committee in the meeting focused on support for the parks; a request for a report from Finance Department professionals who work on bonds; the

timeline; necessary approvals; usage of the monies; funding source; Urban Futures; the sewer bond; the proposed bond for infrastructure; General Fund obligations vs. revenue bonds; revenue measure partnerships; the property tax measure; the structural deficit; cuts made to the budget at the start of the pandemic; the need to put expenditures back in the budget; services that need to be provided; the need to bring a revenue measure forward; the business license tax measure; the housing measure; striking a balance; a presentation by Urban Futures; bond tax measures; revenue measures; potential collaboration with the Culver City Unified School District on an affordable housing project; educating the Committee on the pros and cons of different approaches to a bond; staff agreement to agendize a presentation from the Financial Advisor for November or December if possible; agreement to forward feedback from the City Clerk on government recalls to Committee Members: the standing item to receive updates from subcommittees with reports submitted one week in advance of the meeting; including an update from the Tax Subcommittee; documents submitted with reports; the transition to written reports rather than discussion during meetings; a request for an update on how much has been collected on Measure RE; comparisons to the prior year; and staff requested that the subcommittee submit questions for the bond presentation in advance.
