Kashawn Mariner, Human Resources Technician, provided a summary of the material of record for Items A-1 and A-2.

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding clarification that differences in physical requirements and working condition in the description between Maintenance Worker I and II are an oversight; effective protection from inclement weather; medians and bike paths; and training and experience requirements.

Discussion Regarding Drug Testing Policy and Procedures

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding what happens if an employee cannot provide the required sample; alternate testing; bargaining; Commission responsibility to make a determination; changes since the policy was written in 1994; recreational marijuana; Department of Transportation

regulations; the prohibition on coming to work under the influence; overhaul of the City Council policy; testing methods and efficiency; the bargaining process; separate tests; split sample testing; alternate tests to Federal testing; putting in a system to eliminate the need for the Commission to have to determine which doctor is correct; and a request for updates to the Commission before a hearing comes forward.

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Adjournment

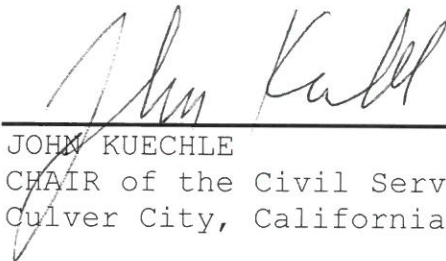

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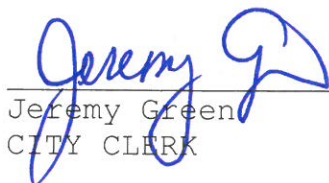
