Discussion Regarding the Month/Date which the Fiesta Event is Held and Possible Motion to Recommend a Change to City Council

Discussion ensued between staff and Committee Members regarding meeting location; length of the pandemic; concern with competing with Halloween; weather concerns; the Jewish holidays; marketing; impetus for the change; ride availability; expiration of the contract with the current vendor and the need to go out to bid with the vendor contract; competition with local school fundraising; combining the event with Halloween; ending early on Sunday for trick or treating; pent up demand to get out and do things; and reviving the parade.

MOVED BY CHAIR GUZZETTA, SECONDED BY MEMBER SWENSON AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE FIESTA LA BALLONA COMMITTEE RECOMMEND THAT THE CITY COUNCIL MOVE THE DATE FOR FIESTA LA BALLONA 2021 TO OCTOBER 29-31, 2021.

Darren Uhl, Recreation and Community Services Manager, expressed support for the proposed date noting that the Parks, Recreation and Community Services department has not traditionally had a Halloween event.




Adjournment

There being no further business, at 7:40 P.M., the Fiesta La Ballona Committee adjourned the meeting to January 6, 2021 at 7:00 P.M.


