Chair Sayles called the regular meeting of the Culver City Planning Commission to order at 7:05 p.m. in Council Chambers and via Webex.

Council Member Eriksson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Sayles discussed ground rules for the meeting; procedures for participation; and she noted that the Commission does not have access to comments in the chat from those participating from home.

Sol Blumenfeld, Community Development Director, discussed the accomplishments of Chair Sayles during her tenure on the Commission; he thanked her for her service; and presented her with a token of appreciation from staff.

Commissioners expressed appreciation to Chair Sayles for her service.

David Voncannon discussed the remarkable record of Chair Sayles and he expressed appreciation for her guidance and friendship.

Item PH-1

PC - Consideration of an Administrative Site Plan Review and Tentative Parcel Map to Allow a Four (4) Unit Residential Condominium Development Located at 3826 Girard Avenue in the Residential Medium Density (RMD) Zone, Case No. P2021-0116-ASPR/TPM (Project)

William Kavadas, Assistant Planner, provided a summary of the material of record.

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding appreciation for the summary of 330 and SB 8; whether three individuals constitute a household for low-income status; the Condition of Approval drafted by staff; indicating that the applicant shall comply with the replacement housing requirements, right of first refusal, and relocation benefits if, in consultation with HCD, it is determined that existing tenants are lower income; and evaluating the household.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER REILMAN, SECONDED BY VICE CHAIR BARBA AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION OPEN THE PUBLIC HEARING.

Chair Sayles invited public input.

The following member of the public addressed the Commission:

Steve Stapakis, Applicant, thanked staff for their efforts and provided a presentation on the project.

Discussion ensued between Mr. Stapakis, staff, and Commissioners regarding location of the solar panels; changes to the windows due to privacy concerns; landscaping; communication with the neighbor; and use of frosted glass.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER REILMAN, SECONDED BY VICE CHAIR BARBA AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION CLOSE THE PUBLIC HEARING.

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding support for the design; ensuring that solar goes on the south side; Conditions of Approval; blending in with single family homes in the area; hesitation with setting a precedent by requiring frosted glass; compromise; perceived issues; next steps in the process; modification to the roof plan to indicate solar on the south pitch; housing streamlining; and size of projects and relationship to the hearing process.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER REILMAN, SECONDED BY VICE CHAIR BARBA AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING ADOPT PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 2022-P012, APPROVING AN ADMINISTRATIVE SITE PLAN REVIEW AND TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP NO. 82792, CASE NO. P2021-0116-ASPR/TPM TO ALLOW A 4 UNIT RESIDENTIAL CONDOMINIUM DEVELOPMENT WITH A RECOMMENDTION TO MAKE SURE THAT THE SOLAR PANELS ARE IMPLEMENTED ON THE SOUTH PITCH OF THE ROOF RATHER THAN THE NORTH PITCH, CONDITION 63 REQUIRES A HEDGE ALONG THE REAR PROPERTY LINE THAT WILL GROW TO A HEIGHT OF GREATER THAN SIX FEET, AND CONDITION 64 INCLUDES AN SB 8 COMPLAINCE CONDITON THAT SHALL BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO ANY PERMITS BEING ISSUED.
