BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Staff will provide an update on near-term traffic calming and mobility improvements coming to the Fox Hills neighborhood, including:

- Speed humps on Doverwood Dr and Canterbury Dr;

- Street resurfacing, conventional (Class II) bike lanes, and vehicular lane reductions on Green Valley Cir;
- High-visibility crosswalk markings throughout the neighborhood; and
- Traffic signal detection improvements at Buckingham Pkwy & Green Valley Cir.
