BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Staff will present findings of field reviews and planned design and operational improvements to enhance safety

conditions in the areas of El Rincon Elementary School, as well as the area surrounding Farragut Elementary, Culver City Middle and Culver City High Schools.
