RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

At the June 13, 2022 City Council meeting, the City Council made the following reappointments to the Finance Advisory Committee:

- The City Council reappointed Kevin Lachoff as Resident Member to Seat No. 3 of the Finance Advisory Committee for a term ending June 30, 2026.
- The City Council reappointed Andrew Lachman as Local Business Rep Seat No. 6 of the Finance Advisory Committee for a term ending June 30, 2026.

City Charter Section 1401 provides: "Before entering upon the duties of their respective offices, all officers and employees of the City shall take and subscribe to the following oath or affirmation:

"I, [Member Name], do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties upon which I am about to enter."
