BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Role of Ad Hoc Subcommittees

An "Ad Hoc" Subcommittee serves only a limited or single purpose. It is not perpetual, and it is dissolved when its specific task is completed. An Ad Hoc Subcommittee may be formed or dissolved at any noticed meeting, as long as the discussion has been placed on the agenda in advance. Once an Ad Hoc Subcommittee has been created, its only role is to make recommendations to the associated Commission, Board or Committee (CBC) related to its topic area. By consensus of the

CBC, a separate agenda item is sometimes prepared and presented on a specific Ad Hoc Subcommittee subject matter.
