### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

The Public Works Department Mobility & Traffic Engineering Division will provide an update on the Better Overland & Safer Fox Hills Project, which proposes comprehensive mobility improvements along the Overland Avenue corridor and in the Fox Hills neighborhood.
