BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Westside Cities Council of Governments (WSCCOG) has developed a list of projects and a 5-Year Plan for its Multi-Year Subregional Program (MSP) under Measure M. WSCCOG has approximately \$27 million to program in this first 5-year expenditure plan. The WSCCOG MSP Task Force, consisting of transportation staff from each of the WSCCOG member jurisdictions, developed a project list for the first 5-year MSP expenditure plan based on project readiness and transportation priorities identified in the WSCCOG Mobility Study (adopted in 2020) and the Westside Cities Mobility Matrix (adopted in 2015).
