BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

At the March 28, 2023, meeting, the Community Contributions Ad hoc Subcommittee achieved consensus to agendaize this item for discussion at the April 25, 2023, meeting. At the March meeting, the Subcommittee reported on the nominations, explained the subcommittee's decision-making process, and presented the names of the awardees with a short description of their contributions to the community. The full Committee approved the recommendations of the designated nominees to the City Council for receipt of the awards.
