#### PRCS Commission Ad Hoc Subcommittees

An Ad Hoc Subcommittee may be formed or dissolved at any Commission meeting, as long as the discussion has been placed on the Agenda in advance. Once an Ad Hoc Subcommittee has been created, updates are typically given by Members during this Standing Agenda Item.
